## Group Membership

Schools and English departments have the option of taking out a group membership of ETA.

For the equivalent of five or more ordinary memberships paid at a discounted rate the department receives as many copies of all ETA material and as many places at seminars and conferences as are covered by the group membership.

Group memberships paid by schools have refundable GST so they are financially very attractive.

To cover, for example, seven people costs \$425, a total saving of \$114 (incl. GST saved). The department receives 7 copies of all publications and up to seven members of staff can attend ETA PD events—for the normal registration.
