Session 1: Storytelling

Donella will explore the traditions and significance of storytelling within Aboriginal cultures, as well as how teachers might introduce Aboriginal stories into their classrooms in a sensitive and culturally appropriate way.

Session 2: *Owning Your History*

As a 17-year-old, Brianne Yarran wrote and featured in an award-winning documentary about her journey to learn more of grandmother's history as a member of the Stolen Generations. Brianne, along with director and producer Kimberley Benjamin will discuss her documentary and members of the Carine SHS English department will share how they are using this in their classroom.
